

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENT:

At the meeting of January 21, 1981 the Baker House Execon unanimously recommended the following constitutional amendment to the House:

Amend Article III, Section 2 (Members of the House Meeting and the Executive Council) as follows:

Change "No person shall hold more than one seat on the Executive Council, nor shall any seat be occupied jointly." to

"No person shall hold more than one seat on the Executive Council. No seat other than Social Chairman shall be occupied jointly. In view of the difficulty of coordinating House social functions, the position of Social Chairman may be held by either one or two people. Only two people who have been elected together may hold this position jointly."

Constitutional amendments must be approved by a two thirds vote of House residents. An election for this amendment is tentatively scheduled for Tuesday, Feb. 3rd. If the amendment passes then it will be in effect for the General Election the following Tuesday.
