

SPECIAL BAKER HOUSE MEETING Minutes for Wednesday, January 27, 1982

Meeting called to order at 8:01;50pm Norton presiding as secretary; here's what he said, " " Abdelrahman Makhlouf presiding as president.

EXPLANATION: The President and Room Assignments Committee Chairman received a petition calling for a special house meeting to discuss graduate resident priority. "We feel that there is strong opposition to allowing graduate students to deprive undergraduate residents of their acquired priority. The Room Assignments Committee should not set this precedent without House approval," reads the petition.

DISCUSSION: Kathy Bindels described the origin of the petition (Norton took notes but they weren't very explicit, so I don't know what Kathy said; I could make it up though and you'd probably believe me or lynch me. Since living is one of my priorities, I'll leave it at this.) saying, "quote, unquote" Tim Kuo, one of the grad students in question, described his situation (homeless vagabond) and cited the policy of the institute that they do not in general guarantee housing for transfers of grad students, but this year because their wallets and a few dorms are empty, they are letting grads live in institute housing. William "the Reasonable Skam" Skamarock reported that he had not made a decision and would await the house's response to graduate student priority in Baker (despite the dorm's obvious objection to allowing graduates in an undergrad dorm even though they are ex-residents and pals) More discussion from everyone as to where they thought the grads belonged (yes, you can imagine where, can't you?).

Motion by Feldman, second by Biber to place the two graduates' priority as that below the senior class and above the junior class. Motion fails 39-39; when recounted motion still fails 41-43 (funny how that works).

More discussion and suggestions re where to put them (Weiss and Kuo): 106, last two single rooms, bottom of junior class (the Steve Math 'average'), equal to junior class, below senior class, equal to senior class, and above everyone as Colton proposed (We have a long tradition of getting shit on by MIT, screwed, etc so why shouldn't the grads have the best priority so that everyone can feel screwed)

Memorable comments: Math's math: "Freshmen get shitty rooms. Sophomore year life picks up. Junior year you get a big double. Senior year, a luxury suite." It all averages out to 'average'." Colton: "Give them (the grads) a break. They can't get an apartment. They can't get laid. They'll just sit around and complain about their theses anyway and drink beer..."

Students who take a leave of absence, live abroad, are readmitted, who have not spent their 8 terms in school (here or elsewhere) will not be considered as graduate students.

In the interest of discouraging grad. students from choosimg to live in Baker House, while at the same time providing a reasonable chance of getting a single room in the lottery in the event that grad. students are forced to live here sometime in the future; the Room Assignments Committee feels that they should draw at the bottom of the Junior class. This position, ahead and behind half the residents, presents a considerable risk of not getting the best rooms available, but does present a reasonable chance of getting a single.

Graduate students, one living in Baker will only have the right to stay until the following fall without being reassigned in a housing lottery.

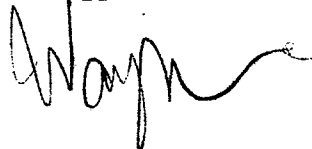
