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# BAKER'S RULES OF ORDER

Due to the confusion at the last House Meeting, we have drafted a set of guidelines as to how future Meetings shall be handled. This procedure has been approved by this Execon and has been incorporated into our By-laws. Note, however, that it has no binding authority over future Execon. -Execon

## I. Calling the meeting to order

When the meeting is ready to start, the Chair (the President, unless absent) will call the meeting to order. The minutes from the last House Meeting shall then be approved or changed (see Voting).

## II. Announcements

After the minutes have been approved, any announcements relating to Baker House may be presented. This will be done by the Chair asking if there are any announcements. If there are, the Chair will grant the floor to an individual who will then present his/her announcement. This will continue until all announcements have been made.

## III. Items of business [without vote]

Items of business in which no vote is needed (basically, general info) will be presented by the Chair for discussion. This discussion will be handled as follows: First, the Chair will ask if anyone has anything he/she would like to say about the subject. Next, the Chair will grant the floor to an individual showing interest, and this individual will have the floor until finished, or until the Chair decides otherwise. No one, other than the Chair, will be allowed to formally interrupt the speaker. Once the speaker is finished, the Chair shall ask if anyone has anything to say directly to what the speaker presented. If so, the Chair will grant him/her the floor and the process will be repeated. If not, the Chair will ask if there is anything else to say concernig the subject at hand. If not, the subject will be considered concluded (for that Meeting) and the next item shall be introduced.

#### **IV. Items of business [with vote]**

Items of business in which a vote is needed (policy determination) will be handled similar to those not needing a vote with the following difference. After discussion of the subject has been finished, instead of considering the subject concluded, the Chair will ask for a motion concerning the subject. If no motion is made, the subject is considered concluded. If a motion is offered, the Chair will again ask if there is anymore discussion; if so, it will be handled as previously mentioned. If not, the Chair will ask for a second. If no second is offered, the motion dies, and the Chair will ask for another motion. If a second is offered, the Chair will then call for a vote. The decision of the vote will be considered binding, and the subject will be considered concluded (again, for that Meeting).

#### **V. Concluding the meeting**

Once all the items on the agenda (see following note) have been dealt with, the meeting will be considered finished. The Chair will then ask for a motion to Adjourn, and all further policy will have to wait until the next House Meeting.

#### **Note: Agenda**

The agenda for each House Meeting is established prior to that House Meeting. Items not on the agenda may not be discussed. (See Constitution for further details.)

### Financial standing of snackbar

\*Budgeted to lose \$800 a year, last year it lost \$1400.

This includes the profit from the vending machines - \$686.57

And the profit from the soda machines - \$2346.22

\*\*\*So without the snackbar Baker would have made \$3032.79

\*This term so far

Total expenditures = -3450.37

Total receipts = +2176.65

In the hole = -1273.72

\*\*\*\*Please note that the major expenditure/loss of the snackbar is wages, not the products.

But this is including the profits from the vending machines - \$67.65

And the profit from the soda machines - \$693.03

So without the snack bar Baker would make \$760.68

### Pros of the Snackbar

- +Very convenient
- +Wide selection
- +May not have to be run at such a large loss
- +A Social aspect of Baker
- +Provides service to Bakerites
- +In keeping with Baker Spirit
- +Provides employment to Bakerites

### Cons of the Snackbar

- Loses a large amount of money
- Difficult to keep going
- LaVerde's just opened
- Obsolete, its purpose can be served by vending machines and socializing in the lounges.
- Other activities in keeping with Baker spirit have been cut.
